# **FIRST YEAR REGISTRATION 2017**

## **BA Media.** Communication and Culture

## NOTE: Maximum number of credits that can be registered per academic year.

A student shall not be allowed to register for more than 120 credits per academic year unless prescribed in the relevant Faculty Rules. In exceptional cases, a deviation may be approved by the Executive Dean on recommendation of the Head of the Department or Director of the School.

isiXhosa for Mother Tongue Speakers (LX111, LX112, LX113, LX114) 6 credits each

**Recommended Electives** (Up to 28 credits)

They may choose another language from the list above.

**Philosophy** (SFV101, SFV111, SFV102 and SFV112) 10 credits each Philosophy is primarily for students who are interested in going into freelance writing, video production, film studies, and cultural studies

OR

**Introduction to Business Management and Entrepreneurship** (EB101 and EB102) 12 credits each These modules open doors for entry into other professional spaces, and offer a wider range of skills in a world that requires entrepreneurs and self-employment.

If students are **undecided** between Philosophy and Business Management, then it is recommended that they register for SF131 and EB101, and attend classes for both modules for the first two weeks.

The same applies to students who are undecided between languages. They MUST make their decision BEFORE 28 February 2017, and communicate this choice to Ms Vermaak, who will assist them.

\*LMC103 is not recommended for first year BA MCC students in 2017, but is available for those that are repeating the module.

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#### **SECOND YEAR REGISTRATION 2017**

Maximum number of credits at second year: 132

# NO STUDENT WHO HAS FAILED MORE THAN 50% OF FIRST YEAR SUBJECTS WILL BE ALLOWED TO REGISTER FOR SECOND YEAR SUBJECTS IN THE BA MCC.

Students who fail module pre-requisites may not continue into the second year of that subject.

### Codes

Please check whether the student has one of the following codes on their record:

- FW: Academic warning (this student has done very poorly in the previous year)
- **FD**: Does not promote (student may only repeat failed modules from the previous year and may not register for any higher year level modules).
- **FG**: Excluded (student has been excluded from the programme and will not be allowed to register unless he/ she has appealed against the exclusion successfully). The student must have proof of successful appeal. If not, they must register late.

**FOUR Language modules** at NMMU 2nd-year level from Afrikaans or English or French or isi-Xhosa plus EIGHT LMC modules. If the student chooses to take elective modules such as a second language, Philosophy, or Business Management, they need only complete six (6) LMC core modules (one of these will be completed in the student's third year due to credit capping).

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### **THIRD YEAR REGISTRATION 2017**

# Maximum number of credits at third year: 144

All students must complete **LMC 311** (20 credits) and in addition select a minimum of three LMC modules in consultation with the programme leader. In addition to the required LMC modules,

students may choose to continue a language to third-year level, or, subject to the approval of the programme leader, any other modules relevant to the overall purpose of the degree.

Students must have at least 120 credits at third year level (in third year modules). That means they must take 7 third year LMC's and LMC311, which equals 125 credits.
